WHEREAS, the Philippine Carabao Center (PCC), an attached agency of the Department of Agriculture, was created by virtue of Republic Act No. 7307;

WHEREAS, PCC is mandated to conserve, propagate and promote the Carabao as a source of milk, meat, draft power and hide to benefit the rural farmers;

WHEREAS, in order to attain the above objectives, the procurement of supplies, services and other materials are needed to sustain operations;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 3 and 4, Article I of Republic Act No. 9184 and Sections 4.1, Rule I of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), public bidding is required in the procurement of infrastructure projects, goods and consulting services;

WHEREAS, the Opening of Bids was held on 4 January 2019 (10am) at the PCC Madamba Hall, National Headquarters and Gene Pool, Science City of Muñoz, Nueva Ecija participated in by the following bidder;



WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, THE COMMITTEE RESOLVES AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that:


- a) **MEDICAL TEST SYSTEMS, INC.** be awarded the contract for the Two (2) units PCR Machine being the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) in the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand Pesos (P 800,000.00);
- b) **MOLAVE TRADING, INC.** be awarded the contract for the One (1) unit Ultra low Freezer being the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) in the amount of Nine Hundred Twenty Two Thousand One Hundred Nineteen Pesos & 03/100 (P 922,119.03);








- d) To recommend for approval by the Executive Director of the PHILIPPINE CARABAO CENTER the foregoing findings.




